Dear Parents:

To help you with your schedule for the summer months, I would like to clarify the Troop's plans for the summer of 2018.

Traditionally, Troop 226 has opted for a challenging summer camping experience. Such will be the case again this year. The Cole Canoe Base near Alger, Michigan, features a well run program that offers the kind of experience we want. We are scheduled in at the Cole Canoe Base during the week of **June 17 – 23, 2018**.

A variety of merit badge offerings and excellent aquatic and scoutcraft programs are available to all boys. The Troop will do its own cooking on our campsite. The cost for the six days of camp is \$390.00, plus the transportation fee per boy of \$110.00 round-trip - \$500.00 total. Families with two or more youth participants will get a small discount. These fees will cover all expenses except souvenirs. Scouts wishing to go to summer camp should decide as early as possible. We will begin accepting the **non-refundable \$150.00 deposit** for your scout's summer camp account beginning at the CofH **February 18th**. Cole Canoe Base requires scouts to be registered and paid in full by May 1, 2018. Scouts registered after that date are charged a late fee. Please use this payment schedule so that we can avoid the assessment of any late registration fees and make the necessary payments to Cole Canoe Base.
