

WRIGHT-PATTERSON AIR FORCE BASE CAMP INFORMATION SHEET MAY 18-20, 2018

DEPARTURE is set for 6:30 p.m. on Friday, May 18th. Please be at the church on time wearing full uniform with all your gear properly packed.

ITINERARY includes camping at Cricket Holler Scout Reservation in Dayton, Ohio. On the return trip, we will be passing through West Liberty, Ohio in order to take a tour of the Ohio Caverns. Drivers will be given a separate sheet outlining all routes for this trip.

UNIFORMING requirements for this camp will be as follows:

- **Friday at departure - Full Uniform (regulation Shirt, regulation Pants or Shorts, and Scout socks - No neckerchief)**
- **Saturday on Base - Full Uniform for all activities. Each and every Scout must be in full Class "A" uniform while on-base. The Air Force requests that every member of an on-base tour be visually identifiable.**
- **Sunday during trip home - "Class B" uniform.**

Scouts not in full regulation uniform may not attend this camp!

FOOD Scouts will need a bag supper for Friday afternoon. Evening snacks will be provided, and meals will be eaten off-base in Dayton area restaurants. We will be giving each Scout a cash stipend at each meal. If they order a meal more than our contribution, they will need some additional food money for this weekend.

MONEY The \$95.00 camp fee is due on Tuesday, May 15th at the latest and will cover the transportation, meal allowances, and admissions to the swimming pool, bowling alley and cavern tour.

We will distribute a food allowance to Scouts before every meal. Scouts will be responsible for holding their own extra food money (and money if they wish to purchase any souvenirs at the Air Force Museum) and must assume all risks for careless loss.

RETURN Scouts may be picked up at the Church between 4:30 and 5:30 p.m. on Sunday, May 20th. A remind message will be sent to parents when we are about 30 minutes out from the Church giving a more precise pick up time.
